A broader COVID-era pandemic-response strategy guided by 3 principles could help avoid future shortages and inequities.

First - A more robust financing mechanism to be made on declaration of a public health emergency of international concern.

Second – A funding mechanism that can address multiple pandemics and builds capacity for future responses

Third – An agreement to share technology and allow countries to waive IP in global public health emergencies could become the norm.

Equitable and appropriate access to quality medicines and vaccines in the Commonwealth: innovative approaches and lessons learned from COVID-19

- **Intra and interprofessional collaboration** of > 300 health practitioners from policy to frontline - health professionals, NGO's, Pharma industry and humanitarian (MSF, UNICEF)
- **Innovation for policy leaders to improve equitable access to quality medicines, vaccines** and medical supplies, within local health systems.
- **Survey** (149 respondents -54 countries) highlighted core themes – enablers and barriers to access
- Forum and survey results informed the **5 policy recommendations** put forward to Commonwealth Health Ministers in May 2021



Recommendation 1: Whole Systems Approach

The individual, broader societal context, including misinformation, medicines availability, accessibility and regulatory barriers, using a multi-stakeholder approach.

Recommendation 2: Price Transparency

Increase transparency and facilitate more informed price setting.

Recommendation 3: Local Manufacturers and Medicine Suppliers

Collaborate and support local manufacturers and medicines suppliers in their region to increase security and sustainability

Recommendation 4: Vaccine Equity

Collaborate with governments and civil society - sharing COVID-19 vaccines, contributing to COVAX, address vaccines hesitancy ; utilizing the full skill set of multidisciplinary health workforce to facilitate universal access

Recommendation 5: Sharing Knowledge and Capacity Building

Take leadership in supporting policy changes towards increased knowledge sharing and local capacity building - temporary waivers of IP, contribution to WHO COVID-19 Technology Access Pool and support multi- stakeholder forum to address supply chain challenges.



What are the main barriers regarding access to medicines and vaccines?



- **Supporting Commonwealth Price Sharing Database;** increasing transparency, facilitating informed price setting and affordability
- **Whole health systems approach** - focus on overcoming inequities in health information and regulatory barriers using a **multidisciplinary health workforce.**
- **Support local manufacturers** in their region to increase security and sustainability in medicines and vaccines supply and reduce inequity in access.
- **Collaborative working** between governments and civil societies from well-resourced countries and counterparts in LMICs sharing expertise resources to facilitate universal access to COVID-19 vaccines for all
- **Leadership in supporting policy changes** for increased knowledge sharing during times of unprecedented global health need e.g. WHO COVID-19 Technology Access Pool

Situation < 2020

- Influenza, Pneumococcal disease
- Sensibilisation
- Monitoring sensibilisation

- Positive evolution of people reached by pharmacist
- A stabilising, even declining vaccination rate



Strengths:

- 3500 pharmacists trained as vaccinators
- More than 500 pharmacists engaged in vaccination centres as pharmaceutical expert

Weaknesses:

- Legal situation of the pharmacist-vaccinator

Opportunities:

- Complexity vaccines: need to take the lead in vaccine preparation (mass vaccination)
- Shortage of vaccinators (mass vaccination)
- Legal situation of the pharmacist-vaccinator
- Opportunity to learn to work together


Threats:

Future:

The best way to predict the future is to create it (Peter F. Drucker)

Unresolved problems, despite much effort

- Annual vaccination campaigns without an increase in vaccination coverage
- Too few and overburdened GPs
- Part of the population not reached by general practitioners and nurses, eg in large cities

The need is clearly mapped

- Evidence becoming more and more known by politicians, governments, health insurers, physicians-academic experts, ...
- The population more familiar with the idea
- The unmet need in large cities of reaching 80% vaccination for covid-19

Enablers

- Search for 'crowbars'
- The profession is educated and ready
- Pharmacists' succes in sensibilisation: 4,8 mio registered covid-vaccination talks in pharmacy
- Pharmacists will encourage patients to choose a GP
- A fully prepared legislative proposal
- A financial proposal that cannot be refused

Ensures that this new service becomes necessary as a solution for the primary care

HOW VACCINATION WORK IN MONTENEGRO? WHO IS IN CHARGE?

- Law on protection of the population from infectious diseases, last update 2021
- Law on the conditions and manner of implementation of mandatory immunoprophylaxis and chemoprophylaxis against certain infectious diseases
- The Ministry, at the proposal of the Institute, forms an Expert Advisory Body for Immunization, which has 11 members and consists of doctors specialists in epidemiology, pediatrics, immunology, neurology, infectious diseases, gynecology, microbiology and other specialties relevant to immunization issues.






